Peter,

The bike has serial number 6815 and 60 on the bottom bracket. Frame is finished in gold metallic color. Super Record derailleurs with the rear one not having a date so possibly a 1987 model. Record hubs front and rear. Type B fork crown, Type 2 seat lug stay, Type 3 rear brake bridge with cutout, Type 2 head lugs and Type B decals. Campagnolo rear drop outs with portacantenna holes. Brazed bottom bracket cable guides, braze-ons for top tube brake cables, shifters and 1 water bottle. Chrome fork crown, dropout flats and right chainstay. Round hourglass chainstay bridge with teardrop reinforcements. 1978 Campione d'Italia Professionisti decal. Modolo Professional brakes and levers with a faded Modolo "Texted" decal on down tube. Cinelli black stem, and Criterium bars Pantographed chainrings & cranks, shift levers.

Chrome clincher rims are without any decals. Campagnolo Super Record seatpost. It has remnants of a bikeshop decal "JOHN'S" believed to have been located in the East Bay area of San Francisco.

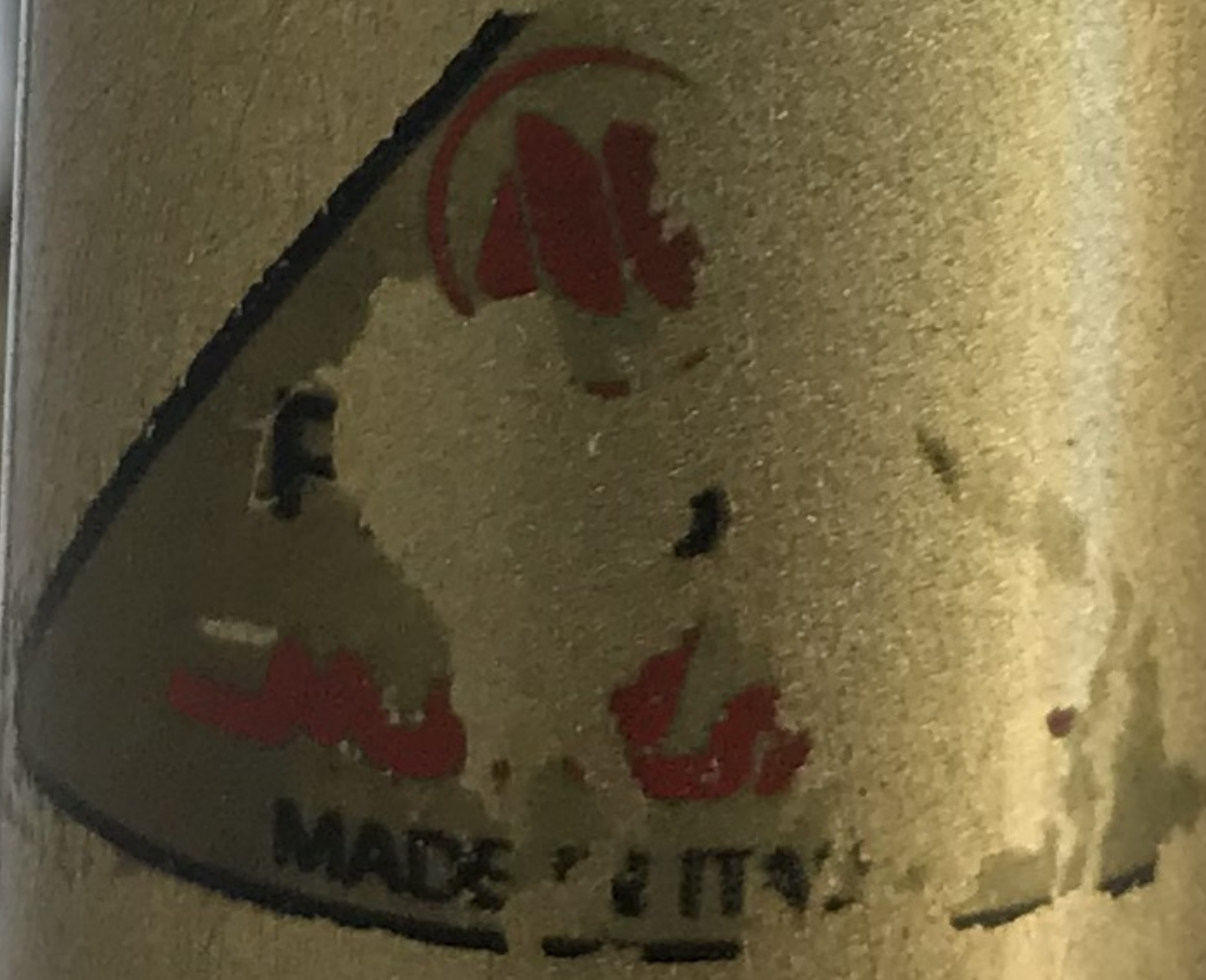
