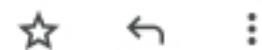

Hello Peter. So this Olmo Professional Deluxe was purchased used by my father for my brother in 1964.

I rode the bike a bunch in my teenage years. My cousin owned a Torpado about the same time, about 1973, 74.

I have the Torpado too.

My cousin and I painted this Olmo more than a few times. About 3 years ago I decided to restore it to a close resemblance of its original form.

The blue paint is a little darker, the red inlaid color on the Balilla brake hoods and Magastroni cranks are my own design.

I also used alloy nipples, but the spokes are the original. Of course the hoods are not original on the Balilla brake levers.

Also did you notice the toe clips are also Balilla. The red ribbon on the toe clips is something I saw done on an old bike and thought it made a lot of sense, as to not mar up your leather racing shoes.

I date it to 1958 with your registry and the Campagnolo Gran Sport rear derailleur.



C985 is the serial number.
