

























Offered in this auction is a vintage circa early 60's OLMO frameset. This a great early 60's Italian road frameset in the condition I found it in. The condition is good overall and this would be a good candidate for restoration. The paint is covered in house paint, the previous finish looks to have been red cromolevato, but sadly it is covered in red primer. The frame is straight with no major damage, but does have a dent in the top tube on the right sight and a ding on the downtube - both are cosmetic and could be easily rolled out and repaired (they are not structural). The frame measures 56.5cm top tube C-2-C and a 57cm seat tube C-2-T. I am not sure of the frame material, most likely Falck or Columbus with Campagnolo dropouts. This frame takes a 26.4mm seatpost with 120mm rear spacing, all threading is Italian - of course. This bike was loaded with rare vintage Campy parts, so high end all the way. Perfect for a summer project.
